Fall is promising an equally stellar line-up AND WAM's biggest event to date: our 20th anniversary celebration in San Francisco on October 12 at Herbst Theater with two headlining bands, a live auction, and honors to the people and organizations that have helped WAM to #ChangeTheFaceOfSound.
